Phenytoin: A Guide to Therapeutic Drug Monitoring

Total serum phenytoin levels reflect both bound and unbound drug However, as protein-bound phenytoin cannot cross the blood-brain barrier, only free phenytoin is active In healthy adults, approximately 90% of phenytoin is bound to albumin Thus, phenytoin levels must be corrected according to albumin levels Formula for Corrected Phenytoin³
